



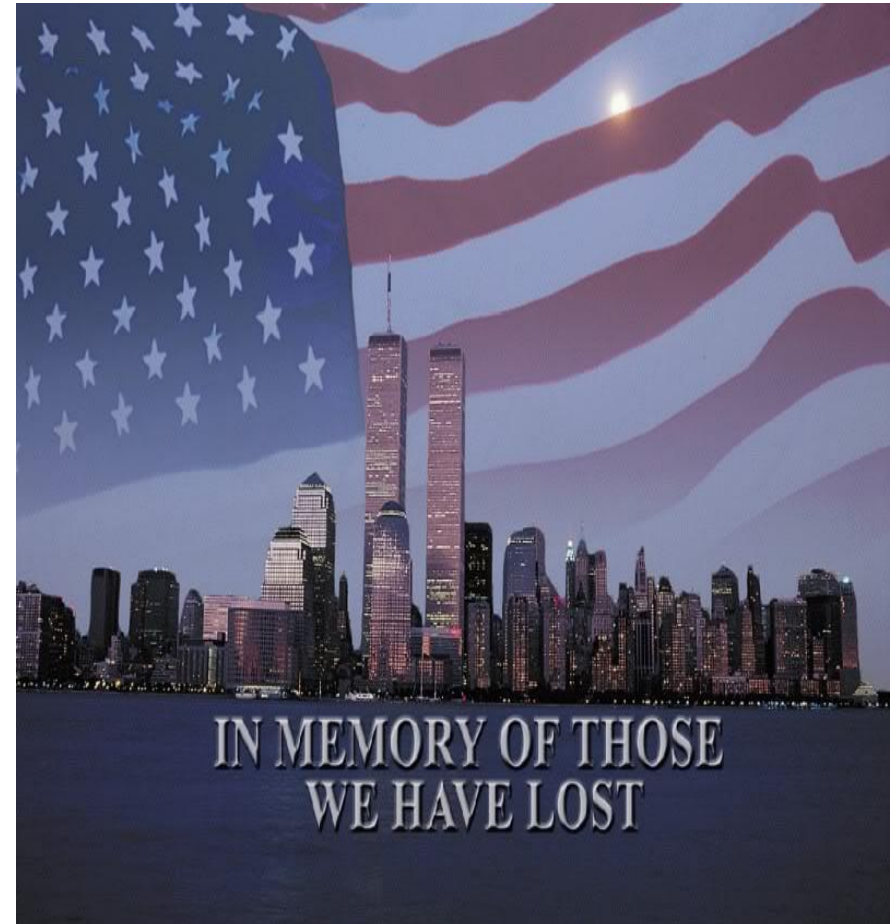
Amazing Grace
